

CHARGES FOR OPTIONAL ACTIVITIES THROUGHOUT THE 2026 SCHOOL YEAR

Charges apply for the provision of extra cost optional activities that are part of an education program and which **voluntary contributions** do not cover. All activities outlined below are optional and if no payment is received, an alternative educational activity will be provided for your child.

The School Board has approved all 2026 extra cost optional activities. The estimated costs provided are at an upper limit and will not exceed the amount shown. If a particular event does not transpire within the school year, no charges for that event will apply.

Payment of the following charges is not required at the same time of finalising payment of voluntary contributions; staff will request payment prior to the event happening through a note to parents.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Excursions K-6 <p>The School Board recognises the value of excursions for students and seeks to support teachers who coordinate activities as part of their teaching programs. Students may participate in extra-curricular activities that involve the cost of transport and/or the activity planned.</p>	Maximum Cost per Student	\$80.00
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Incursions <p>Various Cultural Activities, Guest artists/speakers are offered during the course of the year. On most occasions students could be charged up to \$10.00 per activity.</p>	Maximum Cost per Student	\$50.00
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Swimming Lessons <p>Students participate in daily swimming/water safety lessons (In-term Swimming) over 10 sessions. For students who do not have a season ticket for pool entry, a charge is required for pool entry. This charge also includes possible transport costs.</p>	Maximum Cost per Student	\$40.00
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sports Activities <p>Charge allows for possible transport charges and entry fees associated with sports clinics and interschool sports.</p>	Maximum Cost per Student	\$100.00
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Classroom Activities <p>Students are requested to pay a portion of charges towards special items which may include art, cooking or technology projects.</p>	Maximum Cost per Student	\$40.00
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Camps <p>Year 6 students will go on camp</p>	Maximum Cost per Student	\$1800.00
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Year 6 Graduation <p>Year 6 students have the option to attend the graduation lunch/activity.</p>	Maximum Cost per Student	\$60.00
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Year 6 Term 1 Excursion <p>Leadership excursion/activities</p>	Maximum Cost per Student	\$50.00
